How to get in Ghent with public transport:

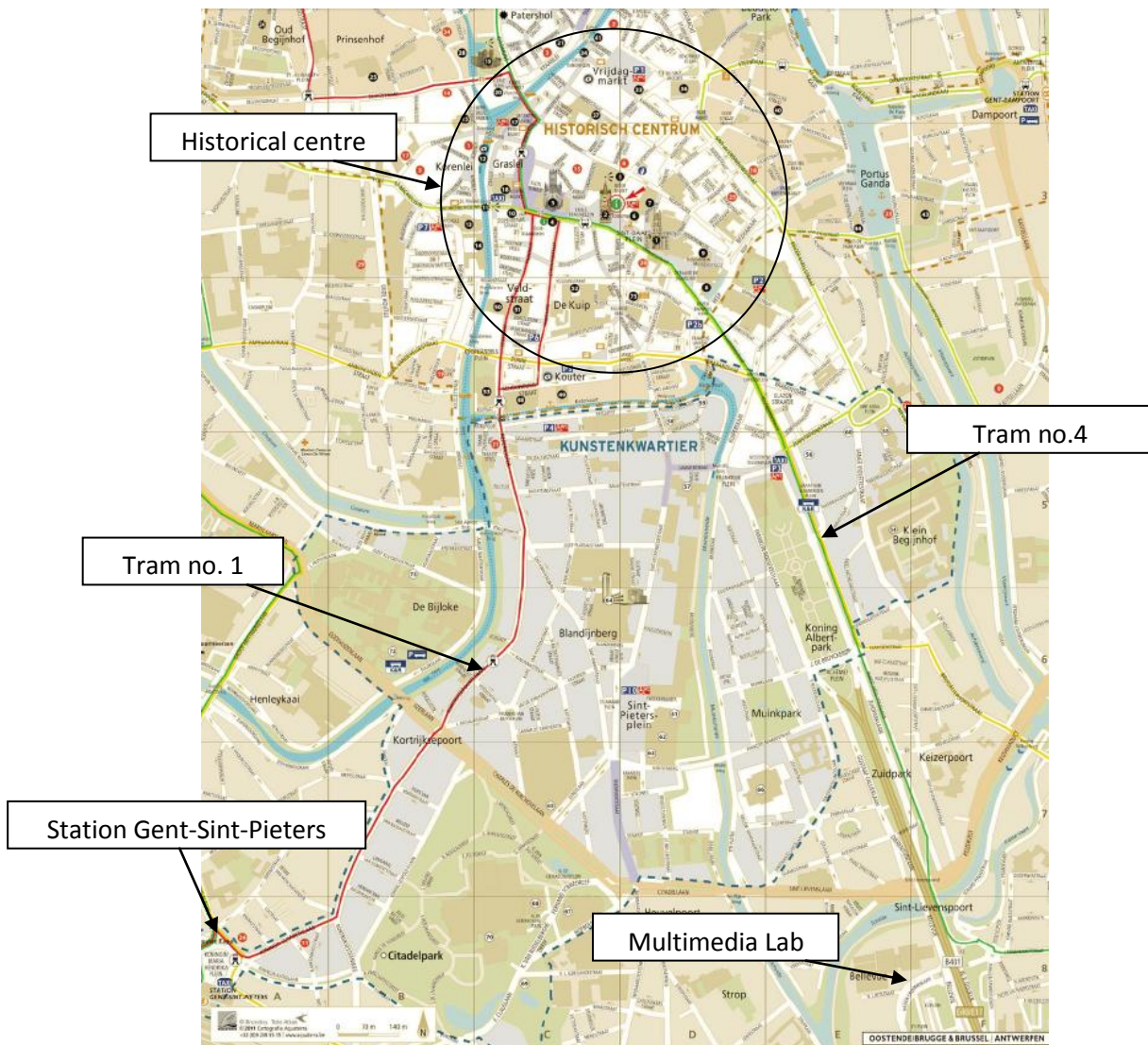
Ghent is easy to reach by train. From Brussels Airport, there are up to 4 trains each hour that connect the airport to station 'Brussels Midi'. From Brussels Midi, a direct train ride takes you to Ghent in 30 minutes. The best place to get off is station 'Gent-Sint-Pieters', the main train station in Ghent.

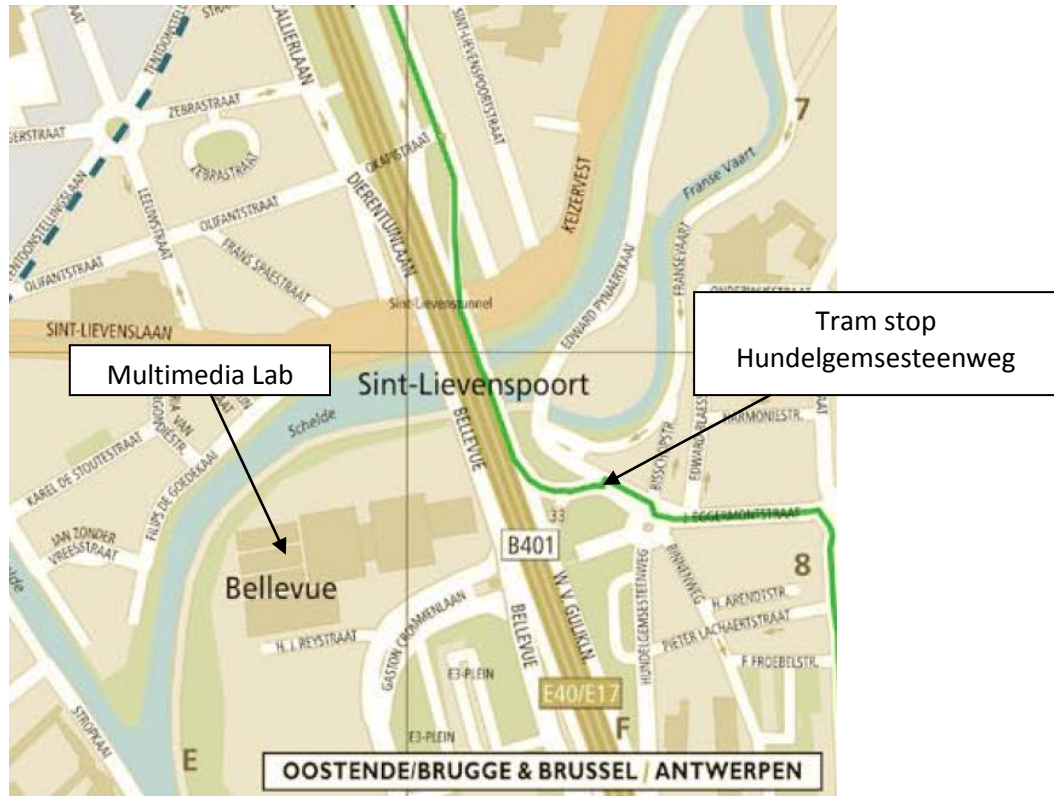
How to get into the city centre with public transport:

From station Gent-Sint-Pieters, tram no. 1 (red line below) will take you directly into the city centre (5-10 min. ride). The best place to get off is stop 'Korenmarkt'.

How to get to Multimedia Lab / IBBT / Zuiderpoort Office Park with public transport:

From the city centre (stop 'Korenmarkt'), tram no. 4 (green line below) will take you to Ledeborg-Ghent (5-10 min. ride). The best place to get off is at stop 'Hundelgemsesteenweg'. You are now in walking distance from IBBT. Multimedia Lab is on the first floor.
